Athens Information Technology (AIT) extends an invitation to prospective students for the above-mentioned Postgraduate Study Program MSITT.

- The **MSITT** is a specialized academic program, consisting of 8 courses and a research-based graduate project. It provides participants with the training necessary to meet the increasing demands of the high-tech labour market.
- The **duration** of the full-time taught course is 12 months, starting on September 12th 2005. The duration of the part-time taught course is 24 months.
- English is the **language** of instruction for postgraduate study at AIT. The program is taught in state-of-the art research and teaching **facilities** at a newly-built modern complex.
- AIT's fully manned and operational **Career Office** actively supports graduates in securing a position to match their qualifications, either within the **INTRACOM** Group of Companies or within other major Greek and international organizations.
- **MSITT graduates** interested in continuing their studies, qualify to apply for the "Master of Science in Information Networking" (full and partial scholarships) a specialized postgraduate program held in cooperation with **Carnegie Mellon**, a world-renowned, top-class university in the USA.
- The program gives participants the opportunity to participate in **research programs** hosted by AIT that offer substantial experience in the field of cutting-edge technologies.
- Those **eligible** to apply include:
 - Graduates of technical universities.
 - Graduates of universities with a first-class degree in Applied Mathematics, Physics, Information Technology or any other relevant discipline.
 - Graduates of technological education institutes with a first-class degree in Information Technology, Electrical Engineering, Automation, Electronics, or any other relevant discipline.
 - Graduates of recognized foreign universities with a first-class degree in one of the aforementioned disciplines.
- **Deadline** for applications is **July 20th 2005**.
